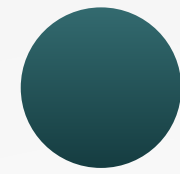

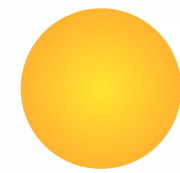


# CAASPP OVERVIEW



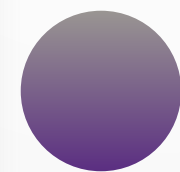
## Purpose

The CAASPP aims to measure student readiness for college and career through standardized tests aligned with California's academic standards in English Language Arts (ELA), mathematics, and science.



## Participants

Students in grades 3–8 and grade 11 typically take the CAASPP assessments.



## Core Assessments

- Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC) for ELA and math.
- California Science Test (CAST) for science.

# WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

## College Readiness

Grade 11 CAASPP scores are used by the California State University (CSU) system and some community colleges to determine readiness for college-level coursework.

## Career Readiness

Employers value skills tested by CAASPP, like problem-solving and critical thinking.

## CCPA Success

Score results directly impact the continuation of our school and charter renewal.
